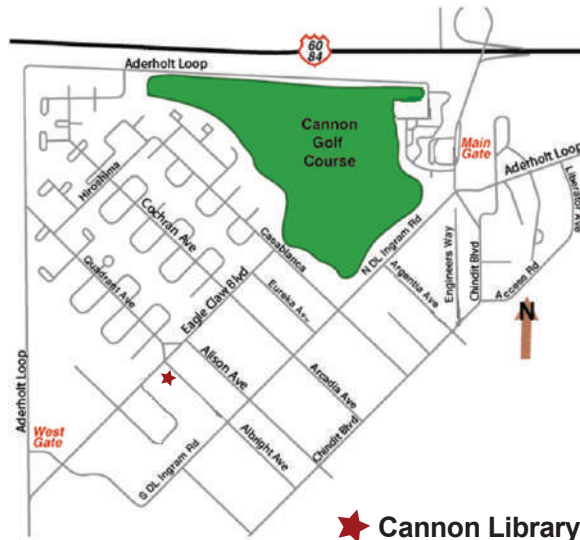
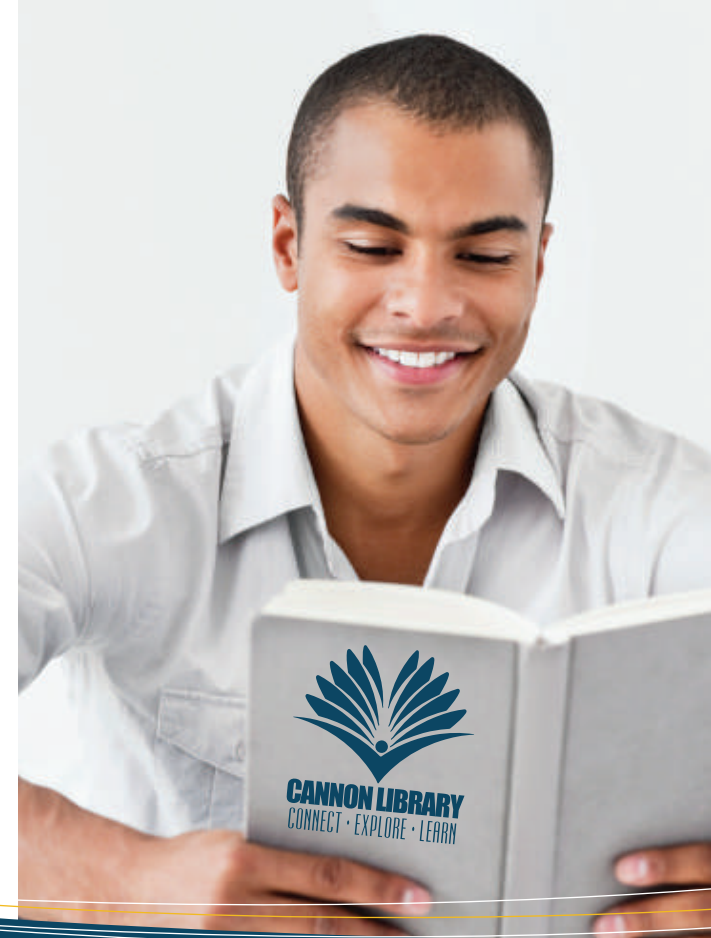

## Cannon Library Overview

### LIBRARY CARDS

Library cards are available for active duty members, retirees, dependents and DoD civilians. To register, visit the library and present DoD identification then, complete a registration form. Minors are issued cards when accompanied by a parent.

### ONLINE ACCESS

Online access to your account is available via the library website. You are able to view current check-outs, verify due dates, renew materials and place holds.

### COMPUTER ACCESS

Computer access is available during library hours. You must have your library card to log on to most of the computers. All computers have CAC readers. NIPR and commercial computers are available.

### WI-FI

Free Wi-Fi is available throughout the library.

### INTERLIBRARY LOAN

Interlibrary loan materials are available from other libraries on behalf of Cannon Library patrons. Up to three items can be borrowed at a time per patron.

### YOUTH PROGRAMS

Story time, toddler time, summer reading program, and many other programs and activities are offered for youth. A calendar of events is available on the website.

### RENEWALS

Renewals may be made up to two times by phone, email, in person, or online. Overdue or on-hold materials cannot be renewed.

### RETURNS

Returns may be made in the library or at the drop box located in the library parking lot.

### LATE, LOST, OR DAMAGED ITEMS

Items that are late, lost or damaged are your responsibility. Overdue notices are delivered by email. Lost or damaged library material is to be replaced by the patron with an exact copy of the item checked out.

### COURTESY & CLEANLINESS

Courtesy is requested from all patrons. Noise levels are to be kept to a minimum, including disruptive children, talking on cell phones, and loud discussions. Cleanliness is important to protect library materials and preserve the facility. Children must be directly supervised at all times.



### MISSION

Get information to make your job easier! The library staff is able to conduct research, purchase materials for your unit, and provide access to electronic resources.



### EDUCATION

Services and resources are available to support educational pursuits from pre-school through doctoral degrees. Your educational success is important to us.
